ANALYTICAL SUPPORT FOR EVIDENCE-BASED POLICY

1ST CALL, JANUARY 2016

Foreword:

The organizer of the conference, the Association of Agricultural Economists of Slovenia (DAES) is a professional association bringing together the agricultural economists of Slovenia for almost four decades. It offers an expert and scientific platform for the exchange of views of the current economic development in agri food sector as well as of the rural development.

Following the examples of fellow organizations at home and abroad, the Association organizes professional meetings and scientific conferences, aiming at public presentation of research results and exchange of different views and ideas. Conferences, since 2007 typically organized every three years, have now become a constant meeting point in the field. They offer platform for the exchange of views and ideas about the economic developments in the agri-food sector and about the challenges of rural development in Slovenia. Further, they offer a chance to present our scientific and expert achievements to the wider interested public.

In December 2016 the 7th DAES Conference will take place in Ljubljana, capital of Slovenia. The conference will follow the established structure, with one central topic and three separate sub-topics. Main topic of the conference will be examined within the plenary sessions and round table.

Besides the central topic, also other important economic aspects or questions, concerning the agriculture, food processing, natural resource management and rural development will be considered at the conference. Respective results and discussions will be presented in three separate conference sections, each addressing a specific conference sub-topic.

Conference objectives and topics:

Central topic of the conference “Analytical support for evidence-based policy” is dedicated to:

- Quality and relevance of the available data for evidence-based policy and possibility for their improvement,
- Usefulness of available data for decision-making in Slovenian agricultural policy.

Argumentation of the main topic:

As many other countries, Slovenia often does not possess relevant data which would enable systematic and efficient monitoring and analysis of economic performance of agriculture at the sectoral level as well as at the level of individual agricultural holdings. Some data are due to different reasons still insufficiently utilized for these purposes (e.g., agricultural accountancy data FADN), while other databases are limited mostly to the production parameters and less to the economic value of agricultural production (registers and other records). One of the main goals of the conference is to start discussion on the state of the quality of databases for evidence-based policy and possibilities for the improvement and increasing the level of inter-operability among them.
